## Homebound Delivery Service

The Cedar County Library (Stockton Branch) is pleased to offer Homebound Delivery Services for Stockton residents in need. Through this program, once a month, library materials are delivered to residents who are permanently or temporarily homebound. Books, DVDS, and audio books can be dropped off and picked up by our staff or Homebound Delivery Volunteers. Materials are checked out for the entire period between deliveries.

## Eligibility

Patrons requesting homebound delivery services must:

- Be a Stockton resident
- Live inside city limits
- Complete a Homebound Delivery Service Request Form (pick up form or call for interview) that helps staff suggest materials that might interest you.
- Have a viable means of contact: phone and/or email
- Have a valid Cedar County Library Card (if needed, the staff or volunteer will help with library card registration before the first delivery)
- Provide a safe and appropriate environment for staff or volunteers to make their deliveries.
