

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A Public Hearing will be held Thursday, August 24, 2023, at 11:00 am at the Geneva Sharp Library/Stockton Branch of the Cedar County Library District, 717 East St., Stockton, MO 65785, at which time citizens may be heard on the property tax rate proposed to set by the Cedar County Library District, a political subdivision. The tax rate shall be set to produce the revenues which the budget for the fiscal year, beginning January 1, 2024, shows to be required from the property tax. The following tax rate is proposed. It is based upon tentative figures provided to the Library District by the Cedar County Clerk and the Missouri State Auditor. These figures may be revised or amended after the public hearing as additional information is provided.
