

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A Public Hearing will be held Thursday, August 20, 2026, at 9:30 am at the Geneva Sharp Library/Stockton Branch of the Cedar County Library District, 717 East St., Stockton, MO 65785, at which time citizens may be heard on the property tax rates proposed to be set by the Cedar County Library District, a political subdivision. The tax rates are set to produce the revenues from the property tax required by the budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026. Each tax rate is determined by dividing the amount of revenue needed by the current assessed valuation. The result is multiplied by 100 so the tax rate will be expressed in cents per \$100 valuation. The following tax rate is proposed. It is based upon tentative figures provided to the Library District by the Cedar County Clerk and the Missouri State Auditor. These figures may be revised or amended after the public hearing as additional information is provided.
